EVERYWHERE IN HEAVEN (COOKHAM)

The current exhibition at the Stanley Spencer Gallery in Cookham, 'Everywhere is Heaven' is a collaboration between the Gallery and Roger Wagner, a modern contemporary artist who was inspired by Spencer. Both artists have produced visionary religious paintings and the exhibition, 'Everywhere is Heaven', is inspired by Spencer's painting, 'John Donne arriving in Heaven'.

The Gallery was the Methodist Church in Cookham Village until 1910, when the congregation moved to the larger, current site in Cookham Rise. Spencer's mother was a keen member of the congregation and took Stanley there as a boy. His picture 'Ecstasy in a Wesleyan Chapel' is owned by the Gallery, but he never turned this into a finished painting.

The Gallery is open from Thursday to Sunday from 10.30am to 4.30pm. Entrance £7, £3.50 for Advantage Card holders and the exhibition runs until 24 March.)

Although many of you will have your own Lent Bible Studies groups running, I thought you might be interested in one that I am leading at Cookham in the Stanley Spencer gallery.

Spencer produced a series of works entitled "Christ in the Wilderness" during the the second world war and through to the end of rationing (1939 -1954). They show Jesus' understanding of his ministry and vocation as well as a love for Creation in a new and vivid way.

This Lent, we will be using Stephen Cottrell's reflections on five of these paintings to explore what it was like for Christ in the wilderness, and what it means to us to be his disciples today.

The study will be on Tuesdays from 2.30-4.00pm on 27 February, 5 March, 12 March, 19 March, with the final study on 26 March at Cookham Rise Methodist Church, Lower Road, SL6 9HJ as the gallery will be closed for the hanging of a new exhibition.
